Provider will develop its own procedures and BABH will audit; Provider will send its Lead Trainer to Basic Medications

Provider will develop med error/remedial education procedure and retrain staff

Crisis and deescalation training is strongly encouraged in all other instances

Note: All of the above must be completed within 90 days of hire (unless otherwise noted) with the exception of Recipient Rights and Training in IPOS .

Note: Basic Health class may be required if the person's support needs require it per the PCP.

*Staff must be trained in medication procedures before passing medications.

**** Provider will determine if WWPI/COG training is necessary based on the individuals' needs as identified in the IPOS.**

New Staff: 2 day WWPI/COG initially within 90 days of hire date and in-person Refresher Class every 2 years

Existing Staff: In-person refresher class every 2 years

All staff: Interim years - provider is responsible for training staff, sign-in sheet required, proof maintained in the home; materials available on web-based training resource site
