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Policy

It is the policy of Bay-Arenac Behavioral Health Authority (BABHA) to recognize the diagnosis(es) rendered by medical professionals acting within the scope of their practice as the diagnosis of record for persons served. Clinical assessments that are bio-psycho-social in nature are performed by master's level practitioners and bachelor's level practitioners. Professional standards and State regulations recognize the diagnoses rendered by master's level practitioners. Thus, bachelor's level practitioners' formulations as to diagnosis constitute diagnostic impressions or a provisional diagnoses and are recommended for consideration or for ruling out.

Purpose

This policy was developed to <u>define how diagnoses will be established and updated</u>, clarify the hierarchy of diagnos<u>tic decision making</u> and define <u>the</u> applicability of diagnoses by level of staff credential.
