


Installing/Updating VMware Horizon View Client for PC, Laptops



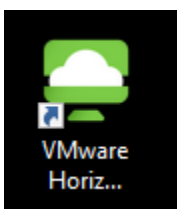

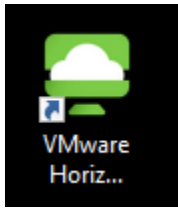
7. It will prompt to restart your device to finish the install

8. Once installed, click on “Launch”. For future use an icon is placed on your desktop.




Log into Virtual Desktop (VDI)


1. Double-click on the VMware Horizon View Client. (if you have not already)



2. Click on Add Server and enter **vdi.babha.org** for the server name. – then click connect
