
MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

CORPORATE COMPLIANCE TRAINING

K. Amon reviewed the Corporate Compliance Training PowerPoint Presentation and provided education to the Board regarding components designed to prevent occurrences of health care fraud or abuse at Bay Arenac Behavioral Health (BABH). This included information related to program integrity requirements, standards of conduct, the Board's role and responsibilities relative to corporate compliance, conflict of interest, prohibited affiliations, the Deficit Reduction Act, the False Claims Act, the Whistleblower Protections Act, Stark laws, Anti-Kickback statutes, and specific examples of fraud and abuse. The duty to report and ways to report potential allegations were also included in the training. There were general discussions regarding abuse categories including service documentation or conditions of delivery, the internal documentation review process at BABH, the historical trends of fraud investigations, the Medicaid Event Verification (MEV) process, capitation funding, differences between capitation and fee for service funding, Medicare and Medicaid dual eligibles, processes for background, licensure, and credentialing checks, Deficit Reduction Act, Medicaid False Claims Act, legacy compliance requirements, and prohibited affiliation requirements.
