Abbreviation/Symbol/Acronym Potential Problem Preferred Term U, u (for unit) Mistaken as zero, four or cc Write "cc" IU (for international unit) Mistaken as IV (intravenous) or 10 Write "international" unit Q.D., QD, qd, Q.O.D. QOD, q o Mistaken for each other. The period Write "daily" and "every other d or god, (Latin abbreviation for after the Q can be mistaken for an "i" day" once daily and every other day) and the "O" can be mistaken for an "i". Trailing zero (X.0 mg.), Decimal point is missed Never write a zero by itself after a Lack of leading zero (.Xmg) decimal point (Xmg), and always use a zero before a decimal point (0.Xmg)MS Confused for one another. Can mean Write "morphine sulfate" or MSO₄ "magnesium sulfate" morphine sulfate or magnesium
